

GROWTH VS. DEVELOPMENT: NEW URBANIZATION IN CHINA



China's urbanization is full of challenges and paradoxes. The consequences of economic growth came along with controversies in social, environmental and cultural domains. "New Urbanization" was formally put forward by the government in 2013, and it is regarded as a signal of shifting towards new growth models on urban-rural development. A series of questions, however, are yet to be answered—What to NEW during the "New Urbanization?" Whether the "city building movement" remains? What action will be aftern to dail with the social and environmental critical process.

The lecture will focus on addressing the characteristics and contradictions during the evolution of China's Urbanization, as well as discussing the development trends under the New Urbanization.

Her publications include "The Morphology of Habitation", "Special Housing's Double-Marginalizing Trap" "Shanghais Industrial Heritage: Past, Current Status, and Future Directions", "Approaches to Urban Design", etc.
